Information about the Stock Grant

Within the framework of a stock grant, KOSTÜMKOLLEKTIV e.V. supports professionally working costume designers who would like to realize an independent performing arts production in Berlin and gives them the opportunity to complete their projects at especially favorable conditions. The costume stock is supported by Berlin's Senate Department for Culture and Europe.

Target Group

The stock grant is intended for professional costume designers with a specific independent project in Berlin in all genres of the performing arts, i.e. theater, performance and dance, including all subgenres such as puppet theater, children's and youth theater or street theater.

Type of Funding

The costume stock of KOSTÜMKOLLEKTIV e.V. is a collection of costumes created from productions that are no longer being performed as well as individual collections. The stock is available for fittings, rental, research and inspiration. It contains simple rehearsal costumes as well as glamorous, custom-made and historical items and offers the opportunity for fittings, during which costume pieces the respective designer brings with them can also be tried on during fittings with colleagues. Many of the costume pieces can be adapted and/or changed in consultation with the administration of the costume stock.

With the support of the stock grant, KOSTÜMKOLLEKTIV e.V. seeks to facilitate a close cooperation between costume designers and the other participants of the selected productions. The grantees can use the stock at especially low fees in order to realize their project. The grant does not include any cash payments or any artistic or handicraft work. We expect the borrowed costume pieces to be returned in a washed and, if necessary, repaired and ironed condition. Any possible repairs we must conduct or losses of costume stock will be handled according to the terms of use. The basis of the cooperation is the declaration of consent by the grantees to our usage conditions (available for download at www.kostuemkollektiv.de/stock-of-costumes).

The grants are awarded less in light of content or aesthetic considerations than in light of the significance of the costume design for the submitted project and its public impact. The naming of our association as a supporter is required in all cases. Part of this is an agreement on mutual naming in publications as well as the provision of text and image materials, posters, flyers and program booklets of the project for publication and documentation by KOSTÜMKOLLEKTIV e.V. We expect the documents for publication and advertising in our social networks and on our website to be sent in a timely: this is the 3rd week before the beginning of the month in which the premiere/presentation takes place.

Procedure / Period of the Application

The application for the stock grant is made by completing the application form, which can be downloaded from the website of KOSTÜMKOLLEKTIV e.V. Applications must be submitted online by email or in printed form by post:

- The application deadline for projects that are developed in the first half of the year (January 1 to June 30) is November 15 of the previous year.
Period of the application: October 1 to November 15 of the previous year.
- The application deadline for projects that are developed in the second half of the year (July to December 31) is April 15 of the same year.
Period of the application: March 1 to April 15 of the same year.

The deadline for applications by email ends at 6:00 pm on the above dates. When applying by post, the date of the postmark applies. The decision regarding the awarding of the grant is usually made four weeks after the respective closing date.
